There will be two parallel halls on both the days. There will be multiple sessions for Allied health professionals including bariatric coordinators, counsellors, dietitians, psychologists, and physiotherapists specializing in care for bariatric surgery patients. There will be a session on manuscript writing and paper publishing as well.

To encourage presentation of high-quality research work, we have made a provision for Ten bursaries for young surgeons selected on basis of quality of submitted abstracts in the form of stay at venue hotel and complimentary registration.

We have collaborated with Dr Haris Khwaja to convene the 46th IBC Symposium as a part of our scientific programme.

With autumn setting in, we expect a pleasant weather in Delhi during the event for you to have a great time in the capital city of India.

### **Abstract Guidelines**

> The title of the abstract should be less than 30 words. The body of the abstract must be concise with less than 250 words.

#### The abstract must have following sections:

- > Background/introduction
- Objectives
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusion

#### There are three types of presentation available

- Oral
- Video
- Poster

Please note that submitting under oral presentation will not ensure that your abstract will be selected for oral presentation. As presentation slots are limited and the abstract may be reallocated for poster presentation. Please ensure that you indicate the presenting author on the abstract. If the submitting author is also the presenting author then please mark this as the presenting author.

\* Tables must be attached into the body of the abstract- a maximum of 2 can be submitted. Please note that inserting tables will reduce your word capacity.

**Videos** - Please submit - along with your VIDEO- the textual abstract, following the Abstract Format instructions above. Maximum size of the video: 500MB. Acceptable video formats are: .mp4 or .m4v Videos should be in a standardized format:

### Clinical presentation and indication for surgery

- Video title
- Preoperative x-ray images/endoscopy/blood results
- > Operative procedure
- Postoperative outcome
- Videos must not exceed 7 minutes in length. Do not include authors or affiliation in the video or body of abstract.
- Careful proof reading and typing are essential, as otherwise the abstract may be amended or rejected.
- > Results reported using statements such as "results will be presented" or "data will be analysed" will not be accepted.



A maximum of 2 abstracts will be accepted per presenting author. Those who have already reached this number can only be listed as co-author. There are no limits of authors per abstract.

### Important Dates

- Abstract submission opens on 1st May 2022
- > Abstract Submission Deadline: 15th August 2022
- > Abstract Acceptance: Will be Intimidated by 1st September, 2022 via email

**Note:** Authors will have a week from the notification date to confirm their participation. The author/presenter must register for the conference before if he/sher has not already done so. Delay beyond that will invite automatic rejection of the abstracts.

### **General Instructions for the Presenters**

- ➤ The time allotted for each presentation is 10 minutes (7+3 for discussion).
- > The presentation will automatically switch off at the end of 7 mins and in no circumstances will be extended.
- > All the abstracts accepted will have to be uploaded into the respective hall preview area at least 2 hours before the time of presentation. Under no circumstances outside laptops will be permitted.

#### **PLACES TO VISIT IN DELHI**



A beautiful park acts as a favourite ornament on the body of the city of Delhi is Lodhi Garden that holds back several architectural works of 15th century. During the Lodhi reign was the construction of the garden took place and it is

located in between Khan Market and Safdarjung tomb. The park possesses Mohammed Sha's Tomb, Sikandar Lodi's, Shisha Gumbad's and Bara Gumbad's tombs within it.



An open air food plaza and craft bazaar, a triumphant spot of people's gatherings and their chatters is Dilli Haat in Delhi which is a venture of Delhi Tourism and Transportation Development Corporation. Dilli Haat is

quite unlike the other markets in the area. It is permanent and open all days. The exact location of it is the commercial centres of South Delhi opposite to the INA market.



A park sprawling across 20 acres of land is the Garden of Five Senses in Delhi located in Saidul Ajaib village near the Mehrauli heritage area. It was a project done by Delhi Tourism and Transportation Development Corporation at

a cost of 10.5 crores. It took three years approximately to come into existence and was inaugurated in 2003. It is built on a rocky terrain with different thematic areas in the garden including a separate section on the lines of Mughal Gardens.



Among the temples in Delhi, Akshardham Temple or Swaminarayan Akshardham Complex is amazingly famous as it is known to be a spiritual and cultural campus in Delhi and also one of the famous places to visit in east Delhi. This complex showcases the traditional Hindu and Indian culture, spirituality and architecture. Tourists from all over the world come to Delhi will visit the temple to understand the spiritual facts of India.



India Gate is an important site to visit when on your tour to Delhi. India Gate has its original name as All India War Memorial that was built in order to commemorate the 82000 soldiers of the

Indian Army who lost their lives during the First World War happened from 1914 to 1921 as well as in the Third Anglo-Afghan War. The war memorial is situated at Rajpath where you can reach by getting down at Barakhamba Road Metro station in Delhi.



It is India's first asymmetrical cable-stayed bridge. The pylon of the Signature bridge is the tallest structure in Delhi and is double the height of Qutub Minar with its 154-metre high viewing

box, which acts as selfie points for visitors. It shortens the travel time between north and northeast Delhi. The bridge is 675 meters long and 35.2 meters wide.



Maqbera e Humayun or the Humayun's Tomb in Delhi is a major historical site in India and also one of the best places to visit in north Delhi. It is the tomb of the famous Mughal emperor of India

Humayun. It was commissioned by the first wife of Humayun who was the chief consort as well, Empress Bega Begum in 1569-70. The design of the tomb was born in the heart of Mirak Mirza Ghiyas- a persial architect invited by Bega Begum herself.
