Donation for AIIMS Poor Fund Account

Donations for poor & indigent patients undergoing treatment at AIIMS (Main Hospital) can be made by Bank Draft/Cheque drawn in favour of "AIIMS Poor Fund Account". Donations made in favour of AIIMS Poor Fund Account are eligible for deduction U/S 80 G of Income Tax Act, 1961. The Bank Draft/Cheque alongwith a covering letter could also be directly sent by post to Medical Superintendent, All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Ansari Nagar, New Delhi-110029.

Notice regarding Donation for Poor Patients referred by NGO's

Many inquiries and complaints are being received from the public for checking of the authenticity of telephonic requests/emails received by them from various NGO's (non governmental organizations) regarding providing of financial support for the poor patients who are undergoing treatment at AIIMS. However, in such cases, it is difficult to verify the authenticity of the requests.

Therefore, donations for the treatment of specific patients should be made only on receipt of request from the Office of the Medical Superintendent, AIIMS or from the Office of the Chief/Medical Superintendent of the respective Centre(s) viz Dr.Rajendra Prasad Centre for Opthalmic Sciences, C.N. Centre, Dr. B.R. A. IRCH, JPN Apex Trauma Centre and CDER. The Bank Draft/Cheque should be sent directly to the Office of the Medical Superintendent/Chief of respective Centre as the case may be alongwith a covering letter. The Bank Drafts/Cheques should be issued in the name of the specific AIIMS Account only. The name of the patients for whom the donation is being made should also be written on the backside of the Bank Draft/Cheque alongwith the O.P.D registration number/C.R. number.
