OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration, 2022 - Constitution of Expert Committee

Government of India has instituted a scheme named 'Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration to acknowledge, recognise and reward the extraordinary and innovative work done by officers of the Central and State Governments.

2. For the year 2022, the scheme for Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration aims to recognize the contribution of civil servants in:-

- a) Promoting Swachh Jal (Clean Jal) through Har Ghar Jal Yojana
- b) Promoting Swasth Bharat (Healthy Bharat) through Health & Wellness Centres
- c) Promoting quality education with an equitable and inclusive classroom environment through Samagra Shiksha
- d) Holistic Development through Aspirational District Programme – overall progress with special focus on saturation approach
- e) Innovations

3. In Innovation category, awards shall be given to Organisations of Central Government, State Governments and Districts for various innovations like innovations in environment conservation, water conservation, energy, education, health, women & child centric initiatives, sustainable framing (Organic/natural farming etc), promoting livelihoods, boosting economy, improving governance, Ease of Doing Business, Faceless Delivery of Public Services, Promoting Digital Payments, Disposal of Public Grievances etc. This is just an illustrative list and innovations in any field of administration are eligible for the awards.

4. There were 16 Awards for Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration, 2022, which comprise total 8 Awards (2 each) for the category as mentioned in para 2 (a) to (d) above and 8 awards for Innovations category. Out of which two awards each will be for Central, State level initiatives and 4 awards for District level initiatives.

5. As per selection methodology stipulated in the awards scheme, applications for awards will be evaluated by Committee at three levels. These are Screening Committees, Expert Committee and Empowered Committee chaired by the Cabinet Secretary.

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6. Accordingly, the Cabinet Secretary has approved the following composition for constitution of Expert Committee (vide Dy. No. CS-7442/22 dated 16.9.2022) for Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration, 2022:-
