Madam/Sir,

Further to this Ministry's letter of even number on the subject it is mentioned that Medical Council of India's code of Professional Conduct, Etiquette and Ethics published in Part III, Section 4 of the Gazette of India, dated 6th April, 2002 was amended vide Gazette Notification dated 21st September, 2016 (copy enclosed). As per the provision of the amended regulations dated 21st September, 2016, the duties and responsibilities of the Physician in general have been substituted as under:

"Every physician should prescribe drugs with generic names legibly and preferably in capital letters and he/she shall ensure that there is a rational prescription and use of drugs".

The provisions of the amended Regulations, in addition to the Regulations dated 6th April, 2002, are brought to notice for strict compliance.
